

INTERSTATE SPILL RESPONSE

PAYNE COUNTY, OKLAHOMA
OCTOBER 2022

Rose Rock responded to a call regarding a spill that had occurred alongside Interstate-35 in Stillwater, Oklahoma between two vehicles, one of which was a transport tanker containing liquefied petroleum gas. Rose Rock arrived at the site quickly and assessed the spill. Our personnel began by removing debris from the roadway, placing sphag sorb to all areas with free liquid, and then sweeping and containerizing all absorbent material. Rose Rock's team then used our in-house remediator agent, EcoGreen, to clean the impacted area with a powerwasher and sucked up all wash water for disposal. Once remediation was complete, a representative from the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) approved the cleanup and reopened the highway to traffic. All collected materials were then taken to a statecertified disposal facility. Manifests from disposal as well as a written report detailing all work performed were then provided to the client for their records.
