



RESERVOIR AND CREEK EMERGENCY REMEDIATION

STEPHENS COUNTY, OKLAHOMA

Rose Rock responded to an oil release in southern Oklahoma for the remediation of two creeks and a reservoir. Our team surveyed the site via boat and began padding the surface water. Booms were placed throughout the water and impacted vegetation was cut and bagged. With the approval of landowners, trees were removed and creekbanks were cleared to till and treat the area with our in-house remediation product, EcoGreen. Hard booms were placed throughout the waterways and the released oil was moved to a collection point. Pipes were added for better flow and booms were routinely switched out, with impacted materials disposed of properly. Our team visited the site daily to assess progress, replace booms, excavate creek banks and impacted vegetation, apply EcoGreen, and backfill areas in the weeks that followed. The project was then closed out by the OCC after their assessment of area regrowth.
