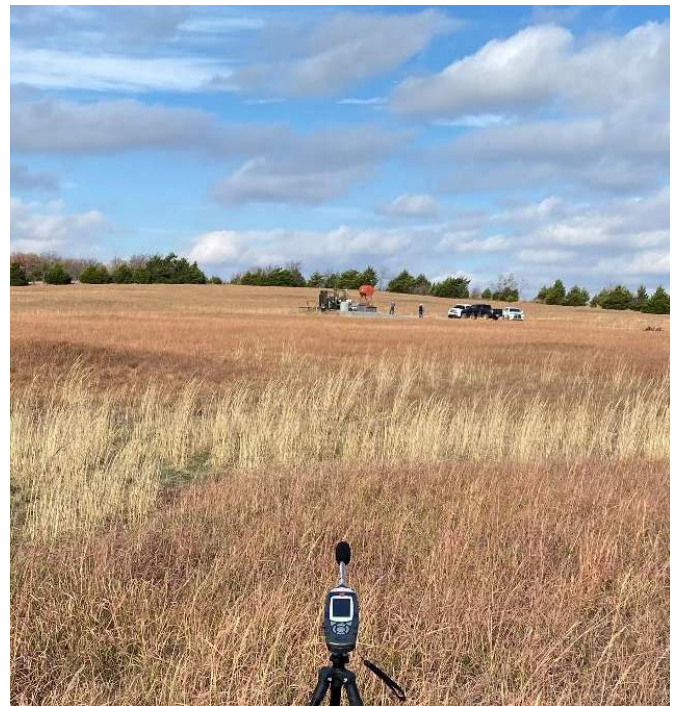




COMPRESSOR STATION NOISE MONITORING

PITTSBURG COUNTY, OKLAHOMA
NOVEMBER 2022

Rose Rock was retained to perform an environmental noise survey assessment north of McAlester, OK. The survey was requested to evaluate the current outdoor noise levels of an operating oil and gas compressor station, excluding worker exposure evaluation. Our qualified professional took surveys at twenty different locations around the site measuring three different parameters over the course of six hours. Wind speeds increased during the survey, so an enclosure protection system was used to protect the equipment from the wind and ensure proper results. A report including the exact positioning of each survey location, monitoring conditions, and the measured noise levels were provided along with the result that no actions are required by law based on our findings.



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
