



STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN

Rose Rock provided an oil and gas service company with a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) for their satellite facility in Union City. Industrial activities occurring at the facility include the storage of waste oil in tanks, staging of parts/equipment/hoses, waste accumulation, oil transfers from oil/water separators and tanks, and water pressure testing equipment pumps, among others. After Rose Rock completed a thorough visit of the site, a SWPPP report was put together detailing the facility, potential pollutants, specific areas of the site with the potential for spills or leaks, options to minimize runoff exposure, and other stormwater control measures including spill response and facility inspection procedures.
