



MAINTENANCE AND STAGING FACILITY SWPPP

Rose Rock provided an oil and gas service company with a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) for their staging and maintenance support facility in Longview, Texas. At this facility, industrial activities with potential exposure to stormwater runoff include the storage of oil and fuel, waste accumulation, staging of parts/equipment/hoses, as well as oil and fuel transfers. During Rose Rock's visit, evidence of soil erosion at the facility was also noted as that could potentially introduce contamination due to residual deposits, tracking, and spillage of dirt, oils, fuel, trash, shavings, and fines that could impact the creeks that runoff discharges into. Rose Rock's SWPPP plan included all of these details, identified the client's prevention team and their required training, who they notify if any spills should occur, and all other federally required information.
